

The Cuba Joint Fire District held a special meeting at 6:30 P.M. on Wednesday, April 2, 2014 in the fire department meeting room at 51 East Main Street, Cuba, New York.

Meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Roll Call: Commissioners: Russ Heslin-present; Mike Johnson-present; John Lafever-present; Doug Rettig Sr.-present; Secretary Richard Seigel-present.

Also in attendance: Vice Pres. John Wilson; Tab Loftis, Chief Dave Hardman.

After reviewing the qualifications for various officers as set forth by the Board of Commissioners and realizing that some of the requirements are nice but really don't contribute a lot to their respective offices and with the provision in the policy that the Commissioners can waive certain requirements Russ Heslin made a motion 2nd by Mike Johnson that the requirements that the commissioners determined to be superfluous be waived. Motion carried by a roll call vote of Aye-4 Nay-0.

Since all the officers have met these qualifications Doug Rettig Sr. made a motion 2nd by Mike Johnson that the commissioners accept the officers. Motion carried by a roll call vote of Aye-4 Nay-0.

Chairman Russ Heslin appointed John Lafever to get with the officers of CFD to review and revise the policy on qualifications. They should keep in mind that some are not taught anymore or called differently but contain the same material.

Motion by Doug Rettig 2nd by John Lafever to adjourn. Motion carried by a vote of 4-0.
