

INFORMATION ON THE VILLAGE OF CUBA DISSOLUTION REFERENDUM

THE PETITION:

The referendum is the result of a petition that was submitted to the Village Clerk on June 18, 2010. That petition was verified by the Village Clerk on June 25, 2010 and is on file in the Village Hall.

- The petition contained 116 signatures.
- 83 signatures (10% of registered voters) were required to bring forth a referendum.
- 102 signatures were verified.
- 14 signatures were not verified for the following reasons:
 - 4 were crossed off and initialed.
 - 4 could not be confirmed on the list of registered voters provided by Allegany County Board of Elections.
 - 6 people submitted letters asking that their signatures be removed from the petition.

THE REFERENDUM:

The referendum vote will be held on Tuesday, September 28, 2010 from noon-9:00pm in the Cuba Village Hall, 17 E. Main St.

REGISTERING TO VOTE:

The Village does not hold a voter registration day. If you reside in the Village but are not registered to vote, please pick up voter registration form at the Village of Cuba Hall or contact the Allegany County Board of Elections. **The last day to register with the County Board of Elections is September 3, 2010. The Allegany County Board of Elections can be reached at (585) 268-9294.**

ABSENTEE BALLOT APPLICATIONS:

Absentee ballot applications are available at the Village Hall, 17 E. Main St. Absentee ballot applications must be received by the Village Clerk **no later than September 21st, 2010** in order for absentee ballots to be mailed to qualified voters.

Absentee ballots must be received by the Village Clerk no later than August 17, 2010 to be included in the referendum.
