BOARD MEETING

**Member Dave Crowley made a motion to accept the application as submitted with a strong recommendation the rectangular version of the sign be used as it keeps with the aesthetics of Main Street. Ellen Scott seconded the motion, all in favor and the motion carried.**

There was discussion brought to the table from Ellen Scott about a Main Street Business that had possibly been “grandfathered” with certain stipulations, regulations, and limits but it is rumored the business has changed hands, so do the previous grandfathered stipulations and regulations apply. Several board members inquired as to what could happen to clean up the business. The boards concerns will be shared with the Zoning Officer, Code Enforcement Officer, and Village Board.
